## Wine

### America

#### Dessert Wine

MARMESA Pinot Noir 'Red Harvest' 2006 HALF (BE) 3 ~~£8.95~~ <sup>28%</sup> **£2.50** **£6.45**

#### Red Wine

DELICATO Zinfandel Old Vines Gnarly Head 2006 Bottle (BE) 4 ~~£9.95~~ <sup>40%</sup> **£4.00** **£5.95**  
 Robust berry flavors and exotic spice notes from the small grape clusters are balanced with French, American and Hungarian oak, which creates heady layers of vanilla and chocolate and a lingering finish. This luscious wine pairs well with raucous fun at barbecue or pizza parties, a family dinner of hearty pasta or chili, and on its own to celebrate personal triumphs.

Gnarly Zin grapes are from Lodi, the zinfamous appellation due to its ideal climate – long, warm summer days and cooling nighttime breezes from the ocean – and its well-draining, sandy soil. Gnarly Head grapes are grown following the Lodi Rules for sustainable farming, which aims to protect the ecosystem. A byproduct of these earth-friendly farming practices is complex and flavorful wine.

MARMESA Shiraz 'Edna Valley' 2005/06 Bottle (BE) 5 ~~£10.95~~ <sup>27%</sup> **£3.00** **£7.95**  
 A superbly-balanced, ripe wine with juicy red cherry and blackberry fruit flavours. Smooth and seductive it has plenty of Californian sunshine but is neither sweet nor jammy. Elegance and restraint are the hallmarks here with a delicious savoury edge to it.

STONE BARN Merlot 2009 Bottle (BE) 23 ~~£6.95~~ <sup>29%</sup> **£2.00** **£4.95**  
 Fruit forward style with hints of ripe cherry, blueberry and blackberry. A lovely soft accessible wine with a dash of vanilla from new French and American oak.

#### White Wine

CHATEAU SAINTE MICHELE Dry Riesling 2009 Bottle (BE) 67 ~~£10.45~~ <sup>24%</sup> **£2.50** **£7.95**  
 "We made a special dry Riesling just for the Northwest for the past 15 years. Slowly we started hearing from customers in other parts of the country who wanted this drier style Riesling. Starting with the 2006 vintage, we were able to make it available nationwide. The Chateau Ste. Michelle Dry Riesling is a dry, crisp, refreshing style of Riesling with beautiful forward fruit flavors, crisp acidity and an elegant finish. It offers brisk, Riesling character of white peach and mandarin oranges with a clean finish. For the 2007 bottling, we were looking for even more minerality and citrus character by sourcing more fruit from the cooler Yakima Valley. This is an incredibly versatile food wine and my new favorite with oysters." Bob Bertheau, Head Winemaker

HESS COLLECTION SELECT Chardonnay 2008/09 Bottle (BE) 31 ~~£10.95~~ <sup>27%</sup> **£3.00** **£7.95**  
 Tropical aromas of freshly-cut pineapple and ripe pear. A soft entry of well-balanced fruit and oak persists all the way to a pleasing finish of honeydew melon and crème brûlée. 9 months in French Oak (30% new) This wine's natural acidity complements tangy, spicy foods and will offset the richness of creamier dishes. Enjoy with Asian chicken salad, grilled tuna with melted anchovy butter and lemon, or a creamy pasta dish with Portobello mushrooms.

HESS COLLECTION SELECT Sauvignon Blanc 2007/09 Bottle (BE) 54 ~~£10.95~~ <sup>27%</sup> **£3.00** **£7.95**  
 Aromas of gooseberry and kiwi play nicely with flavors of lychee, lemongrass and ruby grapefruit. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks and neutral, 5- to 6-year-old French oak barrels. It was not allowed to go through malolactic fermentation in order to retain its crisp acidity. The bright acidity pairs well with salty and sweet combinations such as prosciutto-wrapped grilled peaches, fresh basil and tomatoes, chopped raw vegetable salads and fresh goat cheese.

MARMESA Chardonnay 'Hollister Peak' (Edna Valley) 2007 Bottle (BE) 17 ~~£10.95~~ <sup>27%</sup> **£3.00** **£7.95**  
 Chardonnay is changing its face. More and more producers are showing another side of Chardonnay - forgoing oak-aging so that the crisp, fruit-driven character of the grape can shine through on its own. It takes the right, cooler-climate vineyards, though; the Edna Valley may be Californian, but it's proximity to the cool, foggy Pacific Ocean makes it work for the Hollister Peak vineyard.  
 The Marmesa Chardonnay shows lots of banana, melon and mango notes, leavened by a breadly touch from aging the wine on its lees. It's medium-bodied, with a soft, spicy finish.

EL LAPIZ Malbec/Shiraz 2010 Bottle (BE) 59 ~~£4.95~~ <sup>25%</sup> **£1.25** **£3.70**  
 This Malbec-Shiraz is a perfect blend of these two varieties. The Malbec gives blackberry and toasty oak characters on the nose, while the Shiraz provides an explosion of black fruit and pepper. Together they form a wine with medium body, ripe fruit flavours, and soft, sweet tannins.

**EUGENIO BUSTOS Pinot Grigio 'Altivo' - Uco Valley 2008 Bottle (BE)** 186 ~~£6.45~~ <sup>39%</sup> **£2.50** **£3.95**

If you like Pinot Grigio, try this Argentine example and prepare to be impressed! With a unique winemaking climate, Argentina is producing really exciting wines and they over deliver quality at the price point, so expect the kind of quality that would cost at least another couple of pounds per bottle if this was from Europe! The grapes for this wine are grown at a staggering 1,000 metres above sea level yet are only at the foothills of the incredible Andes mountains. The elevated vineyard produces grapes with an exceptional level of fruit concentration and presents this varietal in its most expressive form. A lovely clean and fresh Pinot Grigio full of zesty citrus and grapefruit. Nutty and floral undertones with a hint of spice. Very very easy drinking! Great value too.

**SANTA CELINA Pinot Gris 2010 Bottle (BE)** 20 ~~£6.95~~ <sup>29%</sup> **£2.00** **£4.95**

This striking Argentinian Pinot Gris from Santa Celina is smoky, rich and spicy; a perfect partner for liver pâté. One could almost mistake it for an Alsatian wine; such is its textured complexity and authoritative finish.

### Australia

#### Red Wine

**GLENGUIN Shiraz 'Stonybroke' 2005 Bottle (BE)** 5 ~~£15.95~~ <sup>25%</sup> **£4.00** **£11.95**

Robin Tedder MW, the man behind Glenguin, is probably unique in Australian wine circles in that he is a Scottish Baron. Preferring the vineyards of the Hunter Valley to the backbenches of the House of Lords, Robin spends his time making wine – and challenging accepted wine making practices - rather than debating the laws of the old country. Something of an evangelist for New South Wales wines, Robin focuses on Shiraz and Semillon, the two grapes that have historically performed best in the region and the results are very impressive indeed. **HENSCHKE 'Henry's Seven' Shiraz/Grenache /Viognier/Mourvedre 2006 Bottle (BE)** 4 ~~£15.95~~ <sup>25%</sup> **£4.00** **£11.95**

The Shiraz, Grenache, Viognier, Mourvèdre blend is a tribute to Henry Evans who planted the first vineyard of seven acres at Keyneton in 1853. He quickly developed a reputation for producing the best wines in the southern colony. Following Henry's death in 1868, his widow Sarah exercised her temperance convictions by closing the winery and uprooting all the winegrapes. This blend highlights the historical introduction of southern French and Spanish varieties to South Australia in those early pioneering days and reflects the history, religion and culture of the Barossa. Deep crimson in colour. Lifted, floral aromas of blackberries, plums, anise and cedar with sage, pepper and mace notes. Sweet, ripe, berry fruit flavours on a complex, layered palate of great depth and length. Cellaring Potential: Great vintage, drink now to 2023

**HOLLICK Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 Bottle (BE)** 12 ~~£17.95~~ <sup>25%</sup> **£4.50** **£13.45**

The wine is a classic Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon showing intense cassis fruit flavours, with a long finish on the palate and soft tannins. The wine was matured in French oak, adding to the wine's structure, but not dominating the pure Coonawarra Cabernet fruit characters. The fruit for the Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon is selected from old vine material from the Wilgha and Neilson's Block vineyards at the cooler, southern end of Coonawarra. Located on the famous terra rossa soil, these vineyards were originally planted by Ian and Wendy Hollick in the 1970s and early 1980s. It will effortlessly cellar for at least 10 years, and is the ideal accompaniment to lamb dishes.

**PETALUMA Cabernet/Merlot 2005/07 Bottle (BE)** 11 ~~£28.95~~ <sup>25%</sup> **£7.20** **£21.75**

Petaluma began making Coonawarra in 1979. Made from a blend of 50% Cabernet Sauvignon & 50% Merlot. An outstanding, sumptuous wine of great breadth & depth with perfect balance. The blackest, ripest, richest fruit are complemented by liquorice, spice & earthy tones. The soft but mouth wrapping tannins are a feature of this hot year Coonawarra wine. It will age well and patience will be rewarded.

**PREECE Merlot 2008 Bottle (BE)** 19 ~~£8.45~~ <sup>24%</sup> **£2.00** **£6.45**

The wines are made with all the care and attention to detail you'd expect of winemaker Toby Barlow and his team and reflect Victoria's cooler climate with an elegant, approachable style in contrast to the bigger blockbuster wines from elsewhere in Oz. Jeremy Oliver described the range in his Australian Wine Annual 2005 as "Simply exceptional, especially at their modest price points." Soft, smooth and plummy with plenty of black berry fruit flavours with mocha coffee and vanilla notes from the oak ageing. Juicy and fresh but with a lovely weight of fruit and fine ripe tannins.

**REDFIN Cabernet/Merlot 2008/09 Bottle (BE)** 603 ~~£6.95~~ <sup>29%</sup> **£2.00** **£4.95**

Redfin was created by Liberty Wines, working with winemaker Tim James, with the specific aim of producing wines from Australia that once again generated excitement at this price level. 55% of the fruit comes from the Riverland region, 30% from the McLaren Vale and 15% from Padthaway. Oak maturation took place using 100% French oak for 14 months. Ruby red in colour with a purple hue. On the nose this wine displays lifted blackberry and blueberry aromas with nuances of mocha chocolate and subtle oak tones. The palate is soft, round and rich with generous blackcurrant, cinnamon and cherry flavours and a lingering finish. A tight tannin structure is complimented by subtle nutty oak. 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot

**SCHILD ESTATE Shiraz 2006 Bottle (BE)** 13 ~~£14.95~~ <sup>27%</sup> **£4.00** **£10.95**

The Schild Estate 2006 Barossa Shiraz is another fine example of a classic regional style from this renowned area and the Barossa regionality shows through at its best in this wine. It is a true expression of generous Barossa Shiraz. The fruit for this wine was sourced from their Angus Brae vineyard in the Barossa's cool south. This wine exudes great presence, lingering flavours and all the hallmarks of a premium Barossa drop.

COLOUR: Vibrant, rich red BOUQUET: An abundance of black pepper, cassis and black forest fruits PALATE: The bouquet follows through on the palate, producing an enticing, complex wine. Soft tannin structure and the careful selection of American oak from three different coopers enhances these rich fruit flavours, typically found in the Barossa. DRINK: Now to 2014 Received DOUBLE GOLD medal at the 2008 San Francisco International Wine Competition.

*Rich fruits on the nose, including plums and red berries, which carry through onto the palate, with a good ripe tannin structure, friendly and approachable.*

#### Rose Wine

CHARLES MELTON 'Rose of Virginia' 2010 Bottle (BE) 55 — ~~£14.95~~ **£4.00** <sup>27%</sup> **£10.95**  
*A wonderfully rich style. Exotic, almost turkish delight aromatics leap from the glass. The Grenache (46%) shows its true colours in the perfume, and the Cabernet and Shiraz add texture to the palate whilst still allowing the wine to retain a lightness of touch for which the Rose of Virginia is known. A pinch of Pinot Meunier and Mataro add just the merest hint of spice.*

INNOCENT BYSTANDER Rose 2010 Bottle (BE) 17 — ~~£9.95~~ **£3.00** <sup>30%</sup> **£6.95**  
*Delicate floral nose with hints of sherbet & musk. Wizz Fizz & fresh rose petals. Palate: Fresh, crisp and dry. Notes of crab apple, gooseberry and cranberries. Food: Trout salad. Cheese platter. Vanilla tart.*

#### Sparkling Wine

PETALUMA Croser Brut 2007 Bottle (BE) 79 — ~~£18.95~~ **£5.00** <sup>26%</sup> **£13.95**  
*This is an exceptional Australian sparkler made in the Champagne Method. Made by the maverick Brian Croser, an exceptionally talented, driven and opinionated individual who has arguably done more for the cause of Aussie wine in the last thirty years than anyone. Petaluma is one of Australia's most important producers, famous for seeking out the finest terroirs in South Australia rather than taking a one-size-fits-all approach to its grapes. This is refined, elegant sparkling wine, with smoky, creme brulee aromas backing up the zesty citrus and pineapple flavours. "One of the finest vintages of Croser to date, this is a fresh, pure sparkling wine with a hint of rose petal perfume on the bouquet and a beautifully clean primary lemon fruit palate. TALTARNI Sparkling Brut 'T-Series' N.V. Bottle (BE) 871 — ~~£9.95~~ **£3.00** <sup>30%</sup> **£6.95**  
*A stylish wine crafted with the holy triumvirate of sparkling grape varieties, the T Series is for everyday life, after all T is for time out! Straw gold with green tinges, a fine mousse and bubbles. A clean, refined bouquet of fresh, floral, melon characters, balanced by zesty lemon. Very fresh and inviting with red berry aromas. The palate is vivacious with an impressive array of crisp apple, melon and citrus flavours complemented by a creamy mid palate. An excellent sparkler, mounds of grapey citrus highlights, combined with the rich red fruit flavours, not overly sweet, dashingly balanced against the refreshing tartness of the it's delightful chalkiness, the lingering finish is crisp with refreshing balanced natural acidity. This wine is an ideal wine to enjoy at any time, chilled with seafood, freshly shucked oysters or antipasto.*

#### White Wine

D'ARENBERG Lightly-Wooded Chardonnay 'Stump Jump' 2008/2009 (BE) 8 — ~~£7.95~~ **£2.20** <sup>28%</sup> **£5.75**  
*The name 'Stump Jump' pays homage to a significant South Australian invention – the Stump Jump plough. As well as clearing the land around McLaren Vale, it was adopted worldwide in the late 19th century because of its ability to ride over stumps and gnarled roots, saving farmers valuable time and energy. Melons, yellow peach, pear and stone fruits on the nose give away the style of this fresh easy drinking Chardonnay. The palate picks up from the nose with refreshing tropical fruits and more yellow peach and pears. The mid palate is beautifully creamy with good weight and the small amount of barrel fermentation adds a touch of integrated spice. Fruity and fresh you need nothing more than a glass to enjoy this wine but it will also go well with a variety of foods including fresh fish, salads and chicken.*

D'ARENBERG Viognier 'The Last Ditch' 2008 Bottle (BE) 36 — ~~£10.95~~ **£3.00** <sup>27%</sup> **£7.95**  
*In its youth, d'Arenberg's 'The Last Ditch' Viognier is a brilliant, mid-straw colour with lifted nectarine, white peach and apricot dominated aromas, as well as enveloping rose and ginger. These also dominate the young palate where thick and viscous fruit showing rose, nectarine and white peaches develop into an unctuous long lasting palate showing ginger and spices; a complex wine offering a huge spectrum of flavours. With bottle age, the wine should develop in colour to a richer, bright-gold. The aroma should also develop in complexity to become dominated by yellow peaches and tropical fruits but all still supported by rose, spices and ginger on the nose and palate. In the mouth, an older Last Ditch will maintain peach and apricot fruit-based flavour but also be distinguished with a fine edge of acidity.*

DEAKIN ESTATE Chardonnay 2009 Bottle (BE) 21 — ~~£7.95~~ **£2.50** <sup>31%</sup> **£5.45**  
*Light yellow with lime green tints. White peach, apple and lime notes with a touch of biscuity oak on the nose. The palate is elegant showing ripe stone fruit and citrus flavours in a touch of malty oak. Middle palate richness provides pleasing mouthfeel and the finish is fresh yet persistent. Rich ripe fruits with hints of cream and vanilla. A touch of oak gives it weight and length. What Australia does best.*

JEFF GROSSET Riesling 'Polish Hill' 2010 Bottle (BE) 5 — ~~£19.95~~ **£5.00** <sup>25%</sup> **£14.95**  
*This is a more typical Polish Hill than the exuberant 2009: shy, reserved and closed. The 2010 Grosset Polish Hill Riesling has restrained aromatics, a hint of lime blossom, some pebbly, wet stone fragrance, powerful mouth-puckeringly dry and pristine lime flavours that are deep, powerful and tightly coiled with savoury, slatey minerality. The finish is pure Grosset: flinty, achingly dry, memorable. 94 points, TheWineGang.com, 01 Oct 10 "Curl your tongue round this elementally youthful Riesling whose intense lime zest tanginess is marked by fine weight, fruit purity and texture with a bone dry minerality, tight structure and firm backbone that tell you it's a wine best cellared for three years - and the rest."*

PETER LEHMANN Riesling 'Art Series' 2010 Bottle (BE) 7 — ~~£7.45~~ **£2.00** <sup>27%</sup> **£5.45**  
*The Barossa has a long and enviable history of being a great producer of Riesling, the white wine variety held by many to be the noblest of all. Most winemakers we know would nominate Riesling as their white wine of choice. Peter Lehmann in fact has often declared on many occasions that Riesling would be his white of choice if he found himself cast away on the proverbial desert island! Bottled immediately and enclosed under screwcap, these wines are wonderfully crisp and refreshing. An attractive pale yellow colour with green tints, it shows delightful citrus characters and hints of nectarine. The palate shows zesty lemon flavours and a taut clean finish.*

The cool nights in the Adelaide Hills ensures an accumulation of elegant and aromatic fruit flavours in the grapes, something that gives this wine its pungency, while the fruit from the warmer McLaren Vale lends depth and fullness to the wine. Bright, pale lemon green in colour. On the nose intense notes of tropical fruit salad, passionfruit, lychee and mango are balanced by a crisp edge of lime. Domäne Wachau's handcrafted wines from the steep terraced vineyards reflect the area's inimitability. The wines are vinified with conscientious focus on terroir and express the mineral character derived from the primary rock soils of the Wachau. Whether an elegant Federspiel or a monumental Smaragd, the Grüner Veltliner and Riesling wines are brought to perfection in the historic wine cellar. The 2008 vintage in Portugal is probably not quite as consistent for reds as the 2007 vintage, and they are certainly differently styled, a little crisper and pointed, but on a winery-by-winery basis, some people did as well or better. Vallado seems to have put together a superb 2008 vintage. The wines seem bright and focused, with the structure to age and develop in the cellar. They are wines worth seeking out!

This process essentially creates a white wine with a pale pink colour. Bone dry and fresh with subtle red fruit flavours and a pleasant creaminess from lees ageing.
