

# EYECAN. Dunell's

EYECAN is Jersey's only charity, established in 1886, dedicated to supporting Islanders of all ages living with sight loss, from infants to the elderly.

The organisation currently supports over 500 clients, offering a wide range of tailored services designed to promote independence, wellbeing, and inclusion.

Independent of any commissioned funding, these services include specialist advice and guidance, low vision aids, mobility training, assistive technology support, social activities, and emotional wellbeing services.

EYECAN works closely with individuals, families, and the wider community to ensure that those affected by sight impairment can live full and active lives. A substantial part of that work includes advocating for Islanders living with sight loss, working with key partners to develop awareness and accessibility.

For four years now, EYECAN has operated and funded its Children's Voucher Scheme to support young people under 12 years old in being able to purchase their own spectacles.

Dunell's are proud to support EYECAN because of the vital role it plays in improving the lives of children and adults living with visual impairment in our community.
