Figeac made courageous choices, including waiting to harvest late and sacrificing 21% of their crop, ensuring optimal ripeness and concentration. As Jane Anson of Inside Bordeaux notes, Figeac demonstrates its ability to "deliver wines that succeed and delight in many different kinds of vintage conditions," cementing its reputation as an estate to trust. Aged entirely in 100% new oak, the wine reveals

notes of spice and pine, with impressive overall depth which Neal Martin of Vinous describes as "very elegant and classical Figeac in style".

"Silky and aromatic, with velvety tannins, the 2024 Figeac is sublime. Floral and savory aromatics meld into a core of blue/purplish fruit, spice, licorice, lavender and menthol. All the elements are so well balanced. The blend is 39% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot and 28% Cabernet Franc, with 8% press wines. Not surprisingly, the 2024 is a very Cabernet-driven Figeac. Production is 60,000 bottles, or 50% of normal, because of low yields and further selection in the cellar. Tasted two times."

Montrose's 95 hectares, situated in a single plot around the Château, benefit from their proximity to the Gironde and its gentle breezes. As Kelley explains in his report, "Montrose was one of the terroirs favored by the 2024 vintage, experiencing comparatively good weather at flowering and at least a moderate hydric constraint at veraison." Key to the team's success were two green harvests which encouraged more homogenous maturation.
