Argentina

DOMINIO DEL PLATA Malbec Late Harvest 2016 (Susana Balbo) HALF LITRE (los) 18 ~~£10.95~~ **£5.00** ^{25%} **£14.95**
The Malbec vineyards for the late harvest are right around the winery in Agrelo, Lujan de Cuyo. The vines are all ungrafted and are on average of 13 years old. Late harvest-style wines from arid Mendoza are incredibly rare due to the lack of moisture and botrytis at harvest time, and RED dessert wines are almost unheard of. Fortunately, Susana has created a sweet, ripe Malbec dessert wine that is both incredibly balanced and totally seductive. Lush and brimming over with ripe black cherry and plums, together with a touch of violets and spice making this an outstanding dessert wine. It is sweet, and 100% naturally so, not sticky or syrupy. This is indeed a virtuoso performance from the leading lady of the Argentine wine scene. This is an amazing thing.

D'ARENBERG The Nostalgia Rare Tawny Port NV HALF (los) 10 ~~£10.95~~ **£5.00** ^{25%} **£14.95**
*The oldest release every year from d'Arenberg, the palate is very lively, tingling with spice and lift - a fantastic balance of freshness and age. The Nostalgia is blended to an average age of more than 15 years, comprising up to 40 various fortified wines.
 Wine Advocate #192 (Dec 2010) Lisa Perrotti-Brown - 91 points - 'A blend of Grenache and Shiraz, the NV The Nostalgia Port gives a pale amber color and nose of spice cake, dates, preserved raisins and fig paste. Concentrated, viscous, sweet and rich, it has plenty of crisp acid lingering into the long nutty finish. Drink it now.'*

HOLLICK The Nectar Botrytis Riesling 2004 HALF (los) 1 ~~£10.95~~ **£8.00** ^{40%} **£11.95**
The Nectar is made from Coonawarra Riesling from the Wilgha vineyard. The fruit was carefully selected and harvested by hand to ensure the integrity of the wine. Gentle pressing and a long cool fermentation retained the vibrant freshness of flavours before the wine was clarified, stabilised and bottled. Golden straw colour with aromas of citrus and honey.

CAMPBELLS Muscadelle 'Isabella Rare Topaque' N.V. HALF (los) 3 ~~£54.95~~ **£15.00** ^{27%} **£39.95**
THE WINE ADVOCATE Robert Parker #189 (Jun 2010) Lisa Perrotti-Brown - 97 points 'The NV 'Isabella' Rare Tokay offers a deep brown colour with the slightest edge of green. The nose is complex with earthy loam and grolle aromas giving way to treacle, toasted hazelnuts and toffee. The palate is unbelievably sweet and viscous but there is also jaw-clenching acidity that perfectly balances that extreme unctuousness. Very long in the finish with layers of nut and spices really developing for those that can actually wait before taking another sip of this gorgeous nectar. These fortified wines are all bottled to drink now. The extended solera aging process has rendered them relatively stable to changes and they can be stored for a good number of years.'

Very sweet, rich and concentrated, it offers very crisp acidity and a long honeyed finish. Drink it now. Very, very sweet, full and unctuous in the mouth, it has crisp balancing acid and a very long treacle and nut finish. Drink it now. The Rutherglen fortified wines are stored in seasoned 450 litre oak casks and a solera system is used to mature the wines. The age of the wines varies from 5-25 years on average.'

THE WINE ADVOCATE Robert Parker #195 (May 2011) Lisa Perrotti-Brown - 94 points 'The NV Grand Rutherglen Muscat gives a medium-deep brown colour and profound scents of dried figs, raisin cake, burnt sugar, licorice, preserved walnuts and black pepper with just a whiff of menthol. Incredibly full, densely packed and sweet in the mouth, it has crisp, balancing acidity and a very long spicy finish. Drink it now. The Rutherglen fortified wines are stored in seasoned 450 litre oak casks and a solera system is used to mature the wines. The age of the wines varies from 5-25 years on average.'

THE WINE ADVOCATE Robert Parker #189 (Jun 2010) Lisa Perrotti-Brown - 95 points 'With a deep brown colour giving a distinctly green hue to the rim, the NV 'Merchant Prince' Muscat has a profoundly intense scent of plum pudding, raisin cake and stewed figs plus a hint of roasted coffee beans and preserved walnuts. The palate is tooth achingly sweet but like the 'Isabella' has the acidity to carry it off. Very thick and rich with an epic, long, gooey raisin finish - this is one for the super-tasters! These fortified wines are all bottled to drink now. The extended solera aging process has rendered them relatively stable to changes and they can be stored for a good number of years.'

CHATEAU D'ARCHE Sauternes 2010 Half (los) 8 ~~£10.95~~ **£5.00** ^{25%} **£14.95**
Overlooking the village of Sauternes and offering a magnificent panorama, Chateau d'Arche is built on the summit of hills that overlook its prestigious neighbours, notably Yquem and Guiraud. The nose shows floral and white fruit flavours of pear and apple. When swirled, notes of candied orange, apricot jam and a subtle smokiness appear. On the palate, the wine is fresh, soft and mineral. This minerality brings tension and finesse, embellished by pure candied notes. It has a long finish.

CHATEAU DE LEVANT Sauternes 2013 HALF (los) 4 ~~£13.95~~ **£4.00** ^{29%} **£9.95**
Shiny gold yellow colour. Open fruity nose (dried apricot) with botrytis notes and honey flavours.

LAFAGE Maury, Grenat (Ely Pyrenus) 2013/15 HALF LITRE (50cl) (los) 24 ~~£12.95~~ **£5.00** ^{39%} **£7.95**
*Deep purple hue and intense fresh fruit aromas. Beautifully balanced on the palate blending cassis and strawberries with chocolate in a luxuriously rich finish. One of the few wines that works well with good quality dark chocolate. Think black cherry truffles.
 Press review: 'This sort of sweet, lightly fortified vin doux naturel red is much more commonplace in France as either an aperitif or to accompany fruit-based puddings of all kinds. From the town of Maury, close to the Pyrenees, the Grenache grapes deliver intense flavours of dark cherries, plums and cassis. CHATEAU BELA Alibernet Ice Wine 2012 HALF LITRE (los) 8 ~~£54.95~~ **18% £10.00 £44.95**
Château Béla has a long history in producing wines. Egon Müller from Germany and Miroslav Petrech have teamed up and are producing a unique selection of fine wines today. Since 2001 Château Béla is producing one of the best Riesling and Cabernet Sauvignons from the Slovak Republic. In addition to traditional wines like these, the winery started to produce ice and straw wines. The production is based on the modern technologies and methods with a yearly limit of around 30 000 bottles. The Château Béla wines are sold through selected wine dealers in Europe, Australia, and the USA. Winefinity is delivering these unique and special handcrafted wines to your premises on demand.

Fortified Wine

Port
NIEPOORT Late-Bottled-Vintage (LBV) 2012 HALF (los) 3 ~~£9.95~~ **30% £3.00 £6.95**
This is perhaps the most significant Premium Port of our range. Winemaker Dirk van der Niepoort calls this the "Little Brother" of our Vintage Port, as the origins of the grapes and vinification methods are identical. Taken from Ports made in the 2005 harvest, this Late Bottled Vintage however has extended cask maturation making it drinkable at a younger age, yet retaining the essence of its superior "sibling". Brilliant red colour with a wonderful aroma of dark fruits and a classy touch of chocolate. On the palate sweet grainy seductive tannins give the wine a superb elegance and interact well with the fruit and fine spirity finish. The wine can be enjoyed now, and will become more complex with further cellaring for a couple of decades. To fully benefit from its qualities we recommend it be decanted before serving. Serve with soft cheeses, mild blue cheese, dark chocolate desserts or a pepper steak!

NIEPOORT Tawny '20 Year Old' Bottle (los) 3 ~~£64.95~~ **23% £15.00 £49.95**
The firm of Niepoort is frequently quoted as being the 'Masters of Tawny Port'; from the harmonious simplicity of Niepoort Tawny, to the renowned quality of the 20 year old, and the exquisite 30 year old, there is complexity and elegance to be found at every level. This has a classic, rich fruit cake array of aromas, complemented with cloves and nutmeg. It is rich and luscious with flavours of honey, truffle and caramel. Great integration and depth, finishing with hints of dry smoky wood. Incredibly sweet and unctuous. You won't be able to put it down.

NIEPOORT White 'Rabbit' Port N.V. Dry Bottle (los) 34 ~~£12.95~~ **23% £3.00 £9.95**
A classic style of White Port, with oxidative handling and good extract from prolonged skin maceration. Serve chilled as an aperitif but it also goes down a treat as a dessert wine or simply on its own at the end of a meal. Brilliant golden / brown colour with a fresh nutty aroma and delicate subdued fruit. Medium sweet on the palate, interacting perfectly with the spirit which in turn gives a superb structure to the wine.

MADEIRA BARBEITO Ribeira Real Boal 20 Year Old Bottle (los) 4 ~~£119.95~~ **17% £20.00 £99.95**
The Boal incorporates Tinta Negra from 1952, 1953 and 1954. Winemaker Ricardo Freitas explains there was no way he could have blended the '52 in the 20 Year Old Verdelho. It was simply too concentrated and would have made it impossible for him to maintain the Verdelho's youth - that tangy chutneyed fruit. The '52 adds terrific woody resonance to this Boal - echoes of history which tickle the back palate most deliciously for an exceedingly long time. True to his word, Freitas has maintained Boal's varietal character. It has a great concentration of singed, caramelised apple tatin fruit. With marvellous integration of flavours and consummate balance, this is an outstanding, truly exciting Madeira.

MADEIRA BARBEITO Verdelho 'Old Reserve' 10 Years Old Bottle (los) 10 ~~£33.95~~ **27% £9.00 £24.95**
This is authentic Madeira. Overall Fortified Wine Trophy at the International Wine Challenge 2009. Tasting: Tom Cannavan 'Rich burnished gold. A little rotted orange note of oxidation of this ripe fruit, with a hint of barley sugar and little floral and exotic fruit notes, as well as a delicate spiciness. On the palate the immediate impression is dry, with a lushness to the texture and a building sweetness through the mid-palate. There is a welterweight of acidity here again, but the creamy, toffeed character balances, and this stays quite rich but very well defined through its acid structure into a long, tangy finish that leaves a real impression in the mouth.'

Spain - Sherry
EMILIO LUSTAU Oloroso Anada 1997 50cl HALF LITRE (los) 10 ~~£19.95~~ **25% £5.00 £14.95**
Nose: Intense dried fruits (especially figs and dates) with a particular aroma of toasted wood and even freshly laid tar. Sultanas and toffee. Candied orange. Whiffs of eucalyptus, floral honey and damp cellars. Hints of herbal syrup. Rather great. Mouth: Sweet, but not sticky in any way, it feels very natural. Surprisingly spicy as well. Mainly pepper. Hints of ripe tropical fruits and molasses. Honey coated nuts. Toasted bread. Hints of cedar oak, walnut cake, cocoa and an overwhelming peppery / gingery warmth in the finish. Vintage sheries or añadas are rare - they go against the regular flow of the solera system. Some of them are even produced quite differently and come closer to port wine than they do to other sheries.

EQUIPO NAVAZOS La Bota 71 Manzanilla 2017 Bottle (los) 4 ~~£28.95~~ **31% £9.00 £19.95**
From a select few casks, Bota no. 71 has an average age of 7 years which gives the wine the perfect balance between developed nutty aromas and trademark freshness. Manzanilla, made in the coastal town of Sanlucar de Barrameda, tends to be the lightest of all sheries, making it the go-to at aperitif hour. A little salty edge to this one thanks to its proximity to the Atlantic. Needless to say, the nutty aromas and salinity on the palate make for a cracking match to salty roasted almonds.

CHATEAU MONTELENA Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 Bottle (los) 5 ~~£49.95~~ **20% £10.00 £39.95**
Nose: The nose is classic Napa Valley, filled with juicy blackberries, rich cocoa, and cassis. After a few moments, dried cherry and a touch of tobacco come into focus along with some wispy notes of fresh violets. Palate: Density and concentration sum up the palate nicely as tight-grained tannin is interwoven among layers of fresh raspberry, mint, and hazelnut. These slowly transition to a subtle richness of molasses and fig that's almost chewy enough to sink your teeth into. Finish: The finish is seamless and complementary to the palate with strawberry jam, Earl Grey tea, and bright, refreshing acidity that should pair equally well with light fare or hardy cuisine.

All of the Amalaya wines are fruit driven in style, with a finesse that unites them. These wines offer incredible value for their quality and truly reflect their 'sense of place'. Tasting Notes: Deep ruby red colour with purple edges, this wine displays intense fruity aromas of red berries, raspberries and floral notes with a touch of spice and chocolate. It is well structured, fresh and fruity in the mouth with soft and rounded tannins. This wine is velvety with a long finish.</i>

<i>After a long wait our supplier has convinced the boys at Tacuil to create a single varietal Malbec for them, and a new label. The label is a bit of fun, it depicts the story we told you in our introduction to the winery. It's a true story! Pre-phylloxera Malbec clones have gradually adapted to the extremes at Tacuil and carry the hallmarks of this amazing terroir with operatic clarity. Big luscious licks of cassis and blueberry pie with scented hints of spice rack on the nose, silky and sumptuous in the extreme with layer upon layer of ripe black fruits. The tannins are very fine and ripe, cradling a finish with subtle notes of liquorice and black olive.</i>

<i>The shape of things to come? We certainly think so. CARA SUR Bonarda - Barreal, Calingasta Valley 2015 Bottle (los)

2 — ~~£10.95~~ **£6.00** **30%** **£13.95**

Sebastian Zuccardi and his friends have thrown away the rule book here to make a Bonarda that forces a thorough reevaluation of this wonderful, underrated varietal. The bunches are first hand selected, then individual berries are chosen and tossed into 15Kg plastic troughs, where they are then danced upon by foot to produce a very, very dark juice with an abundance of beautiful tannins. Bottled unfiltered, the wine is uncompromising in every respect, a truly extreme thing; dark and profoundly aromatic with exceptional concentration and balance. Only 2,400 bottles were made and we are happy to say we got a sizeable chunk of that for the UK. This is a wine crafted by people doing it for love in a breathtaking location. Taste the Love!

"This is the fourth vintage of this wine, produced from old, parral-trained vines in the rediscovered region of Calingasta at 1,500 metres. Spicy, firm and grippy, with sappy, whole bunch flavours, no oak and crunchy bramble, raspberry and blackberry fruit. CATENA Cabernet Franc 'San Carlos' 2015/16 Bottle (los)

The Catena Cabernet Franc presents a purple colour with red ruby tones. The nose offers elegant aromas of spices, and fresh herbs as thyme and rosemary, red berries, cassis and raspberries, with layers of cedar. The mouthfeel is full and rich with cassis, raspberries flavours and notes of black pepper and oregano. The finish is bright and fresh with finely grained tannins.

CRUA CHAN Malbec - Altamira (Michelini Brothers) 2015 Bottle (los)

From the slightly off-the-wall, enviably talented husband and wife winemaking team of Gerardo Michelini and Andrea Mufatto, a Malbec that defines to a large extent the magic of Altamira, an amazing high altitude enclave of the Uco Valley. A sensitive nose full of minerality and fragrant flowers introduces an intense, sophisticated Malbec perfectly sown up in fine-grained tannins and laced through with delicate acidity.

"Crua Chan is a new addition to the Gen de Alma range, sourced entirely from Altamira and aged for six months in oak. DE ANGELES Malbec '1924', Vistalba 2013 Bottle (los)

9 — ~~£22.05~~ **£5.00** **22%** **£17.95**

Grapes are only ever from De Angeles' one small vineyard - 'Viña 1924 Parcel 3' - and the age of the vines partly explains the stunning concentration here; but don't expect a 'blockbuster', this is elegance itself. These un-grafted vines are trained low and pruned double guyot with 7,200 plants per hectare and everything in the vineyard is geared around the preservation of tradition. Everything is done by hand. harvesting, de-stemming, berry selection. Fermentation takes place in small stainless-steel tanks and after only a brief spell in used oak the wine is aged for 24 months in bottle prior to release. TASTING: Deep ruby red in colour, lovely aromas of plums and sweet red berries, silky-textured in the mouth with incredible length. Elegant yet intense, fresh, complex, superbly balanced and, best of all, very moreish. One of the best Malbecs we've ever tasted.

A big chunk of Rye is used to give the beer a spicy, earthiness, mashed up with Cara malts to create a rich, bold mouthfeel. Zesty Southern hemisphere and american hops are used in abundance to balance the residual sweet malt character. Masses of dry hops are piled after fermentation to spike a wild blend of tropical, spicy aromas.

The result is a dark brown beer that smells of cocoa, roses, and some orange. The body is quite light, and it is carbonated more highly than usual for a porter to make it more refreshing. It's quite light in texture and tastes of Turkish delight dusted with cocoa powder - chocolate, rose water and fruit. Dry finish.
